AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 11-06, PASSED FINALLY AUGUST 29, 2006, TO ADD THERETO SECTION 6.5 (D) REQUIRING SIGNIFICANT INDUSTRIAL USERS TO NOTIFY THE CITY OF CHANGES AFFECTING POTENTIAL FOR SLUG PISCHARGES, AND TO ADD TO SECTION 6.13 A REQUIREMENT THAT INDUSTRIAL USERS MAINTAIN RECORDS ON BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES STANDARDS AS SET FORTH IN 40 CFR 403.3(e)

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT: Ordinance 11-06, is amended to add thereto Section 6.5 (D) to read:
 - D. For purposes of this requirement, significant change includes any change of process that affects the potential for slug discharges.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT: Ordinance 11-06, Section 6.13 is amended to add at the end thereof:

The POTW and all industrial users shall maintain records to a Best Management Practices Standard, as set forth in 40 CFR 403.3(e)

- SECTION 3. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.
- SECTION 4. <u>REPEALER</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
- SECTION 5. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after final passage and approval by the Mayor where such approval is required.
