FORM I: CARELESSNESS WITH FIRE CITATION FORM.

**Carelessness With Fire
(Within 100 Feet of A Structure)**

No person shall, wilfully/deliberately, or through carelessness or negligence, set fire to or cause the burning of any material, in a manner as to endanger the safety of any person or property.

Elements: A person is guilty of this offense if:

- (1) He or she wilfully, deliberately, or through carelessness or negligence;
 - (2) Sets on fire, or causes to be set on fire or cause the burning of
 - (3) Any material or object - name the material or object:
(examples are: any structure, woods, brush, grass, land or fields, any vehicle, any furniture, clothes, toys or goods, wares or personal property of any kind.)
 - (4) In a manner as to endanger the safety of any person or property.
- (1) Choose one or more: Wilfully; Deliberately; Carelessly; Negligently.
 - (2) Choose one or more: Set Fire To; Cause To Be Set Fire; Cause the Burning Of.

Second offense	\$100
