(1) In established business and commercial areas, the building setback line shall be the uniform setback line observed on the same side the the the in question between two intersecting streets or for a distance of 100 feet on each side of the lot. In the event of variance of the abutting property, the setback that is nearest to thirty-five feet from the right-of-way line shall prevail as the minimum setback.
(2) All buildings, including accessory buildings, shall not cover more than the indicated percent of the lot.
